

## **ORDINANCE 2026 -1**

### **AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF LIQUOR RETAILER'S PERMITS FOR PREMISES WITHIN THE TOWN OF GREENTOWN**

WHEREAS Indiana Code § 7.1-3-9-3 permits a city or town with a population under five thousand (5,000) to "enact an enabling ordinance consenting that liquor retailer's permits may be issued to applicants in respect to premises located within the town's municipal limits; and

WHEREAS the Town of Greentown has businesses that are, or have, operated with a liquor retailer's permit and wishes to adopt an ordinance consenting to the issuance of such permits within the town's municipal limits;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF GREENTOWN,  
INDIANA, THAT:


**SECTION I.** Liquor retailer's permits may be issued to applicants wishing to utilize such permits within the municipal limits of the Town of Greentown.


**SECTION II.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances which may be in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


**SECTION III.** Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful, or which by operation of law shall be deemed unenforceable, shall be omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION IV.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage by the Town Council of the Town of Greentown and publication as provided by law.


