Greentown Continues Efforts to Protect Drinking Water

The source of Greentown's drinking water is groundwater produced from wells located within the community. To help protect the underground aquifer and the water supply wells from contamination, the Town of Greentown has developed a Wellhead Protection (WHP) Plan, which was approved by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) on February 16, 2006. Since then, the WHP Local Planning Team (LPT) has met annually to update the Plan and implement management strategies to protect our drinking water supply. The WHP LPT held its annual meeting on January 19, 2023. The WHP Program focuses on public awareness, education, spill prevention, and reporting.
