

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

On or about December 31, 2017, the Town of Greentown intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community Rural Affairs for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Planning program. This program is funded by Title I of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development planning project that will include the following activities: Study of Storm Water Drainage System. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$35,000.00. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low- and moderate-income persons is \$17,920.00. The Town of Greentown also proposes to expend an estimated \$4,000.00 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: Storm water Utility Fund.

The Town of Greentown will hold a public hearing on December 19, 2017, at 6:30 p.m., at the Town Hall. The Town Hall is located at 112 North Meridian Street, P.O. Box 247, Greentown, Indiana 47936-2470. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact Teresa Duke, clerk treasurer at 765-628-3263 no later than December 15, 2017, every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of December 19, 2017 at the Town Hall, in Greentown, Indiana 47936. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to the Clerk Treasurer, no later than December 15, 2017 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the Town of Greentown and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
