On or about May 25, 2018, the Town of Greentown intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community Rural Affairs for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) SIP program. This program is funded by Title I of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: Improvements to their Stormwater System. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$600,000.00. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low- and moderate-income persons is \$307,320.00. The Town of Greentown also proposes to expend an estimated \$3,617,000.00 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: State Revolving Loan Program.
